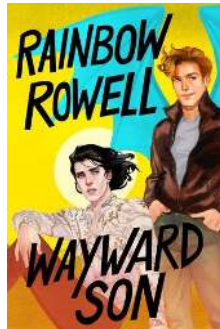


The Dark Prophecy

by J.K. Rowling

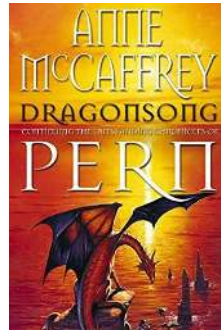
While attending the Magical Congress of the United States of America in 1926, Newt is pursued by the wizarding authorities when dangerous beasts escape from his magical briefcase.

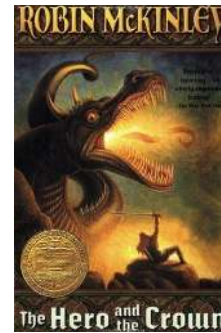


Dragonsong

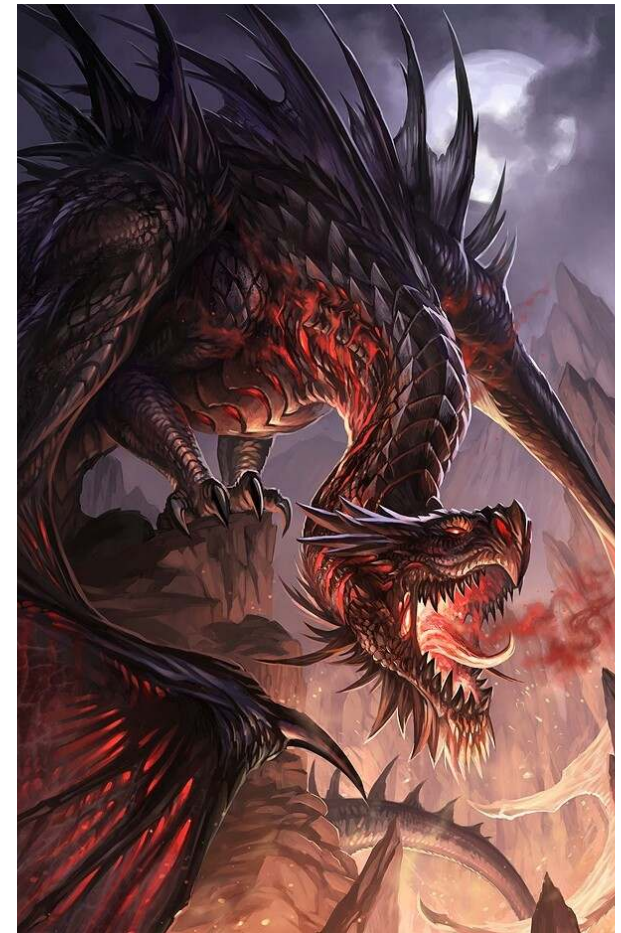
Dealing with Dragons

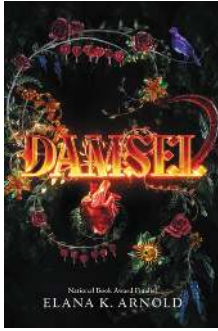

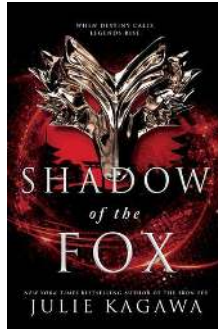


The Black Witch by Laurie Forest
